2023 Ballet Summer Intensive Frequently Asked Questions

What is Summer Intensive? Summer Intensive is a week-long session occurring daily. The week consists of ballet technique classes in addition to other classes often including pointe, contemporary, jazz, ballet history, dance nutrition, pantomime, variations, and jumps and turns. Students aged 10 and up by June 1st are invited to participate.

How long does it last? There are 6 weeks of the program this year, each week running Monday through Friday. Four sessions will run during daytime hours, two sessions will run in the evening hours. Dancers may opt to participate in as few as one week and as many as all six as space allows. Simply indicate your desired dates on your application.

Audition process: For dancers who are part of the Campaneria Ballet Company, no audition is required for participation in Summer Intensive. Miguel and the faculty will determine level placements for the program.

For non-company dancers or those who are not already Campaneria students, participation in a live class or a video submission will be required in order to properly determine level placement. To arrange a day and time to audition, please reach out to us and we are happy to set it up for you.

How will you determine who gets to participate in each week? Priority for space in each week of the program will be determined by the date/time we receive the COMPLETED application, front and back copy of health insurance card, and application fee. We will begin accepting these February 1st.

Tuition: The tuition rates decrease as the number of weeks attending increases. Additionally, we offer early bird payment days. If full tuition is paid by those dates, additional discounts apply. For a complete list of the rates, please see the attached packet.

We are happy to create a personalized payment plan. Simply reach out to us and we will discuss options with you.

What are the hours? For the daytime sessions, classes will be held 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM. For evening sessions, classes will be held from 4:00 PM to 9:00 PM. Dancers may arrive 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the day. If a dancer needs to arrive earlier than those 15 minutes or stay later than the scheduled end, there is an additional fee.

What does the schedule look like? Each day will begin with two hours of ballet technique and one hour of pointe. Dancers not on pointe will take the pointe class on demi pointe or may move to a separate studio for additional ballet technique training. After a meal break, the schedule will vary each day often including contemporary, jazz, lyrical, musical theater, ballet history, health and wellness, pantomime, jumps and turns, and variations.

What if I want to attend but cannot commit to a full week? As space allows, dancers are welcome to drop into any Summer Intensive classes. The drop-in rate is \$22 per hour. Dancers who plan to drop in must complete the application process. Please reach out to us to schedule any drop-ins.

^{**}Tuition and housing fees are non-refundable without a doctor's note indicating medical reason for withdrawal. After June $1^{\rm st}$, refunds due to medical issues are eligible up to 75% of the total tuition.
